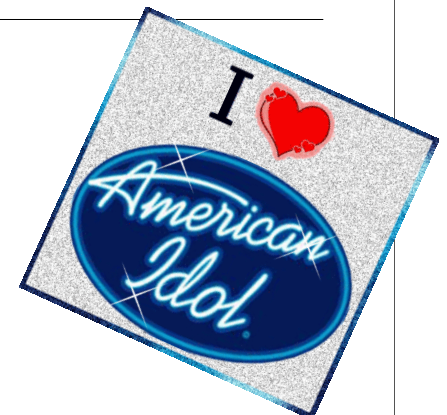
TCEP Students Shine in....TCEP IDOL!
